

Instructions for **Showcase**Saturday, April 12th 11.00am



- Pure Energy, please arrive at FPDS no later than 10:15am on the morning of Saturday, April 12th, and Arise & Shine, no later than 10:30am. You may park on the Belhaven side of the school and enter through the door at the big steps near the new offices. The showcase will begin promptly at 11:00am, however, dancers will need to warm-up, get dressed, and receive instructions before the show begins, so we ask that you please be on time. Parents may drop off their dancers in the Innovation Lab (dressing room) and proceed next door to the gym to find a seat.
- Students may come dressed in shorts and t-shirts, however, their hair and make-up <u>MUST</u> be done already.
- All of the dancers' costumes will be labeled and laid out with their dance shoes, tights, hair pieces, and accessories in the dressing room. Each dancer will also be provided with the sequence of the show so that they can keep up with which routine is next up and be ready in full costume. There is no need to go to the dressing room between routines to help your dancer change. We will have assistants (experienced high school and college dancers) who are very qualified in assisting the girls with costume changes. Between routines, dancers must go directly to their places in the dressing room and immediately change into their next costume. Once changed, they must stay at their assigned spaces (no running around) until directed to line up for their next performance.
- Please style your child's hair with a middle part and low bun. You have been provided with a bun shaper to assist with this process. Scan the code below to view a tutorial video. Dressing room assistants will help with securing the various hair accessories into each dancer's hair.
- We would like the girls to wear a little light make-up so their sweet faces can be easily seen.
 However, the makeup should look very natural. Just a little powder, blush, and mascara is all that is needed. I have purchased each girl a soft pink lipstick that can be applied when arriving the morning of the showcase.
- Dancers need to have clean fingernails for performance day. No colored nail polish.
- You are welcome to take pictures throughout the show, however, we ask that you stay seated. We
 will have a photographer taking pictures throughout the showcase that we will gladly share with
 you afterwards.
- At the end of the program, we will recognize each dancer with a special certificate and small gift.
- Following the showcase, dancers may return to the dressing room to change back into their streetwear. They may take all costumes, showcase t-shirt, dance shoes, tights, lipstick, earrings, and program with them to keep. We ask that you please leave <u>all hair accessories</u> as we plan to reuse them in the future.
